takes its name from the popular expression used by the people of Málaga to describe the precipices and cuts that abound in our mountains: “Volaeros”. Its most recognizable spelling has been chosen, which also appears as a place-name in the National Geographic Institute’s mapping of the area.

The illustration on the label faithfully reproduces an 1800 engraving by Isidore Laurent representing the bay of Málaga and the *Mountains of Málaga* in the background.
